Introduction

This document sets out the Charges and other amounts payable in connection with the Facilities Access Service.

Charges in this Facilities Access Service Price List are separated into recurring Charges and non-recurring Charges. Recurring Charges are periodic amounts which are payable in each Billing Period that a Service Element is supplied by **nbn** to RSP. Non-recurring Charges are payable only when certain activities or events occur (e.g. Co-location Activations).

Discounts, credits, rebates and waivers to Charges in this Facilities Access Service Price List may be offered from time to time, as set out in the Discounts, Credits and Rebates Annexures.

Certain provisions of this Facilities Access Service Price List may be affected by the terms of an SAU.

This document forms part of the Facilities Access Service Module.

Part A: Recurring Charges

Part A sets out the recurring Charges which apply in connection with the supply of the Service Elements of the Facilities Access Service.

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Part B: Non-recurring Charges

Part B sets out the non-recurring Charges which apply in relation to the supply of specific activities in connection with the supply of the Facilities Access Service.

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Part A: Recurring Charges

Section 1 sets out the recurring Charges which apply to the Service Elements of the Facilities Access Service. The specific Charges which apply will depend on the Service Elements selected by RSP.

1. Recurring Charges

The recurring Charges per Billing Period for the Service Elements of the Facilities Access Service are:

* **Note:** Includes performance of an initial feasibility study and one post-installation inspection.

Part B: Non-recurring Charges

Section 2 sets out the non-recurring Charges which apply to specific setup and activation activities in connection with the supply of the Facilities Access Service.

2. Setup and activations

(a) The Charges for the setup and activation of the Facilities Access Service are:

Additional post-installation inspection for the nbn ® Building Entry Service	Labour Rate + Materials

(b) In this section 2:

- (i) **Labour Rate** means \$75.00 for each of the total number of labour hours required to perform the relevant activity (rounded up to the next full hour); and
- (ii) **Materials** means the cost of materials necessary to perform the relevant activity.

Section 3 sets out the non-recurring Charges which apply to specific service management activities in connection with the supply of the Facilities Access Service.

3. Service management

(a) The Charges for service management relating to the Facilities Access Service are:

(b) If RSP requests that **nbn** augment the fibre tie cables between an Equipment Rack supplied by **nbn** to RSP, and an **nbn**® ODF under section 4.3.6.1 of the [Facilities Access Service - Service Technical Specification](#), the following Charges apply:

Provision and installation of a subsequent fibre termination tray/patch panel in a RU of the relevant Equipment Rack with 24	\$6,205

Provision and installation of a fibre termination tray/patch panel in a RU of the relevant Equipment Rack with 72 pre-cabled and terminated single mode fibre tie cables installed in the first half of the fibre termination tray/patch panel	\$10,381
Provision and installation of 72 pre-cabled and terminated single mode fibre tie cables in the second half of an existing fibre termination tray/patch panel in the relevant Equipment Rack	\$8,847
Provision and installation of a fibre termination tray/patch panel in a RU of the relevant Equipment Rack with 144 pre-cabled and terminated single mode fibre tie cables	\$18,495
